Playland, dedicated as a National Historic Landmark in 1987, has provided family fun since 1928. Often referred to as “Rye Playland,” it is America’s only government owned and operated amusement park. In addition to the thrilling amusement rides, Playland also has picnic areas, restaurants, three ice-skating rinks, a swimming pool, and two beaches totaling approximately 7,900 feet of shoreline. **(Seasonal) Routes 13, 75, 91**

Lyndhurst, a Gothic Revival-style mansion which served as home to former New York City mayor William Paulling, merchant George Merritt, railroad tycoon Jay Gould, and their families through the years. The site includes a steel-framed Greenhouse complex, the oldest regulation bowling alley in the United States and a collection of more than 4,000 objects. Stroll through the estate with its Rose Garden, fern garden, rock garden, specimen trees, the now aged lindens and spectacular views of the Hudson River. Beautiful hiking and bike trails are also available, as well as a popular summer concert series. **Routes 1w, 1t**

The Emelin Theatre, located in Mamaroneck, and founded in 1972, is the oldest continuously operating performing arts theater in Westchester County. The Emelin is well-known for its high-quality and affordable programs, and is one of the few performing arts venues in this region which offers a broad mix of entertainment appealing to all ages and tastes. In addition, the Emelin produces its own theatrical performances and attracts diverse audiences throughout Westchester County and beyond. **Routes 60, 61**

The Westchester County Center is a premier indoor venue featuring performances, concerts, sporting events, and trade shows year-round. Make sure to save the date each May for the “Salute to Seniors” expo! **Routes 1w, 5, 6, 13, 14, 15, 20, 21, 40**

Saxon Woods Park is a 700-acre property offering a variety of recreational facilities. The park contains an 18-hole golf course, miniature golf, the county’s largest swimming pool, hiking trails and picnic areas. **Route 60**

The Jacob Burns Film Center is a state-of-the-art theater and cultural arts center presenting independent, documentary and foreign films. Special lectures and classes are offered featuring renowned filmmakers, actors, authors, critics and scholars. **Routes 6, 19**

The Westchester Italian Cultural Center (WICC) offers art exhibits, language classes, films, lectures, concerts and culinary programs for children, adults and seniors. **Route 8**

The Neuberger Museum of Art, initiated in 1974 with Roy R. Neuberger’s donation of 108 works of art, is the premier museum of modern, contemporary, and African art in Westchester and Fairfield counties. The museum presents more than a dozen changing exhibitions each year ranging from work retrospectives to thematic surveys of contemporary art. Year-round public programs such as curator-and docent-led exhibition tours, artist lectures, hands-on workshops, concerts, dance performances, readings, social events and family festivals are offered by the museum. **Route 12**

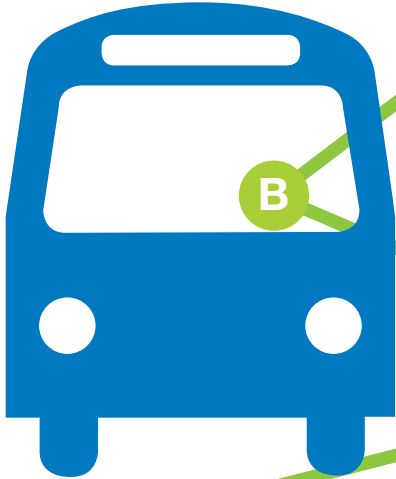

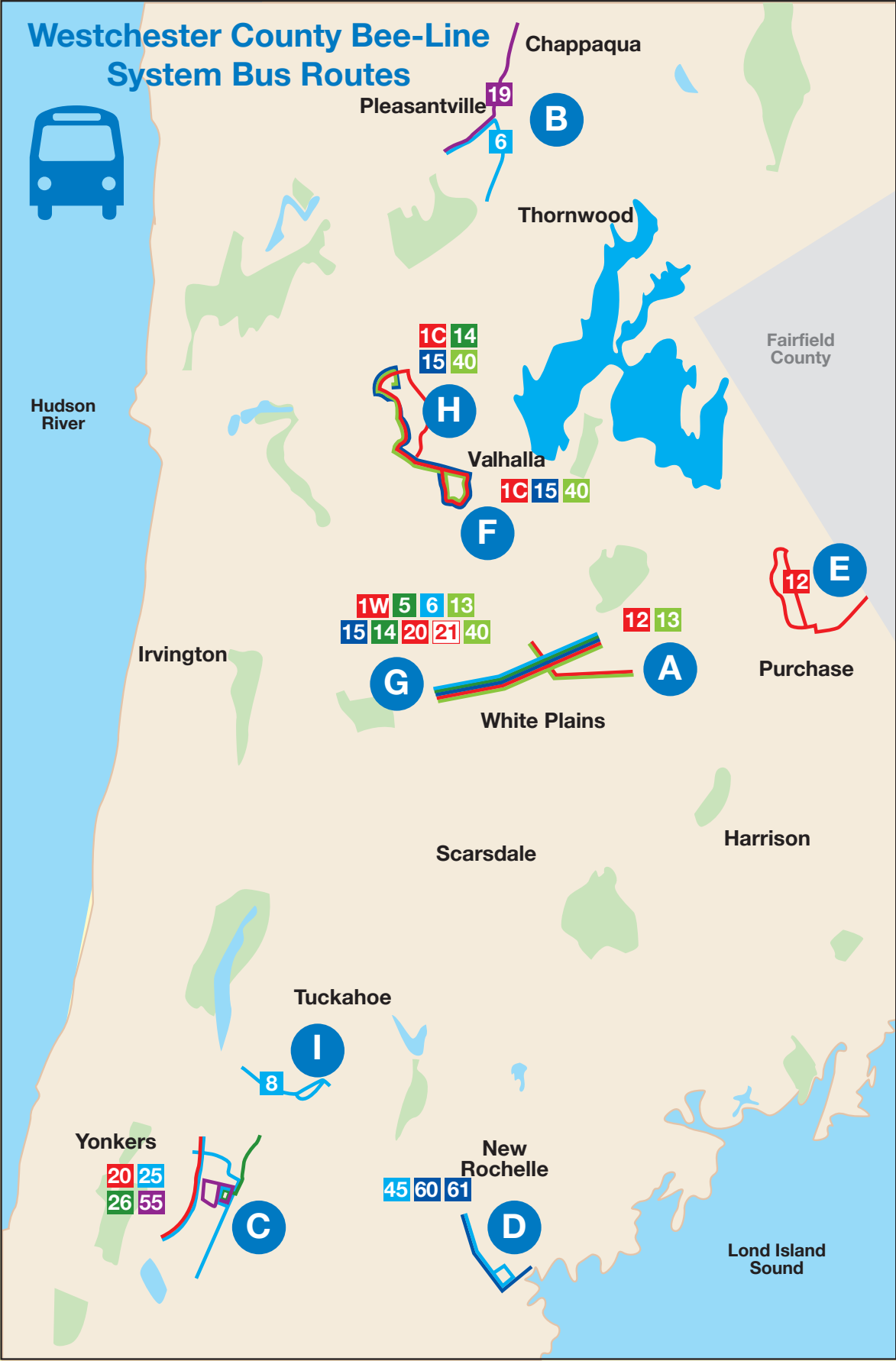
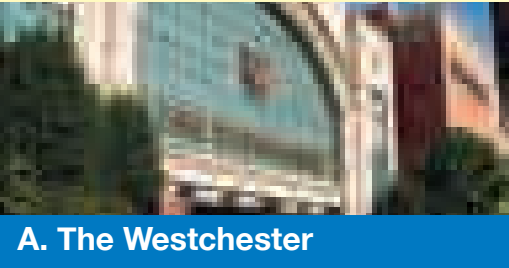
